Prof. Dr. Mirco Raffaini

Professor Mirco Raffaini is an internationally recognized leader in oral and maxillofacial surgery, with a distinguished focus on orthognathic surgery, aesthetic-reconstructive facial procedures, and rhinoplasty.

He received his Medical and Dental degrees and his specialization in maxillofacial surgery from the University of Parma, Italy. He completed a Master's in Maxillofacial Surgery at the University Hospital DIEU in Nantes, France, a Master's in Plastic Surgery at the University of Nancy, France, and a Master's in Hospital Management at Bocconi University in Milan, Italy. In addition, Professor Raffaini undertook advanced fellowships in Craniofacial Surgery, Head and Neck Surgery, Orthognathic Surgery, and Rhinoplasty with leading surgeons in Paris, Mexico City, Zurich, and Los Angeles.

From 1988 to 2000, he was Assistant Professor to Prof. Roberto Brusati at the Hospitals of Parma and San Paolo of Milan. From 2000 to 2019, he served as Associate Professor of Maxillofacial Surgery at the University of Florence, and from 2020 to 2024 as Clinical Professor of OrthoFacial Surgery at the University of Milan. Since 2006, he has been the Founder and Director of the Face Surgery Center, with clinics in Parma and Milan. He currently holds visiting professorships at the University of Milan, the Universitat Internacional de Catalunya in Barcelona, Boston University in the USA, and the University of São Paulo in Brazil.

Professor Raffaini has authored more than 150 scientific publications and is a frequent keynote speaker at international congresses. His research interests include functional-aesthetic jaw surgery, digital surgical planning, and interdisciplinary orthodontic-surgical approaches. Over his career, he has pioneered innovative concepts and techniques for the treatment of complex craniofacial and orthodontic cases.

Globally respected as a clinician, academic teacher, and researcher, Professor Raffaini continues to shape the field of facial surgery and remains a key figure in the international maxillofacial community.
